

## Disc - Rear Brake - Remove and Install (One side) (12 225 0)




## Remove


- WARNING: As rear brake system is subjected to high hydraulic pressure the foot brake must not be applied when the caliper is removed.
- 1. Slacken the wheel nuts, raise the vehicle and remove the rear road wheel.
- 2. Release the handbrake lever.




3. Detach the handbrake cable from the lower arm.



- 4. Remove the brake caliper assembly.
  - Suspend the caliper to prevent damage to the flexible brake hose.
- 5. Mark the relative position of the hub and disc.




- 6. Remove the brake disc.
  - 1 Remove the spring washer.
- 2 Remove the brake disc.



## Install

**NOTE:** If the original disc is to be refitted ensure that the match marks are aligned.

- 7. Refit the brake disc and secure with a new spring washer.
- 8. Refit the brake caliper assembly.
- 9. Refit the handbrake cable to the lower arm.
- 10. Apply the handbrake lever.



11. Refit the road wheel and lower the vehicle.
