



Remove

- 1. Standard preparatory measures:
- Make a note of the radio keycode.
- Make a note of the preset radio stations.
- · Lay protective covers on the fenders.




- 2. Remove the driver's side airbag as described in Operation Number. 40 700 0.
- 3. Raise the vehicle.
- 4. Detach the engine undershield (right-hand side shown).







- 5. Drain the coolant.
- 6. Lower the vehicle.



7. Detach the left-hand plenum section from the connecting pipe (only on variants with 2,9 V6 24V Cosworth engines).




8. Detach the left-hand plenum section from the V-shaped connecting pipe (only on variants with V6 24V Cosworth engines).




9. Detach the left-hand plenum section (only on variants with 2,9 V6 24V Cosworth engines).

Unscrew the six bolts.




10. Disconnect the heater hoses from the heater radiator connectors.




11. Remove the connector cover plate together with the seal from the bulkhead.

Remove the gasket.




12. Remove the steering wheel.




13. Detach the right and left-hand multifunction switches.


Disconnect one multiplug on the left and one on the right-hand side.



14. Detach the instrument cluster bezel.




15. Detach the instrument cluster bezel (continued).




16. Detach the instrument cluster bezel (continued).

- Disconnect all the multiplugs (varies depending on equipment level) from the back of the instrument cluster bezel.




Disconnect the three multiplugs.

- 2 Remove the selector lever cover.


Unscrew one screw on the left and one on the right-hand side.



20. Release the centre console (continued).


- 1 Remove the two front screws.

Pull back the centre console.




21. Remove the lower section of the fascia crash pad.

Unclip the bezel from the hood release lever.




22. Remove the lower section of the fascia crash pad (continued).


Detach the hood release lever and unhook the cable.




24. Unclip the fascia crash pad upper bezel.



Remove the two screws on the passenger's side.








28. Pull the hose of the centre vent nozzle out of the heater housing.




29. Detach the demister nozzles (right-hand side shown).

- Disconnect the multiplugs from the control motors.




31. Detach the heater housing from the bulkhead.






